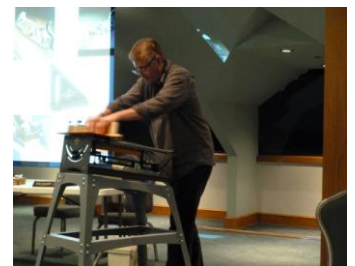
The 16th Master Woodworker's Show
